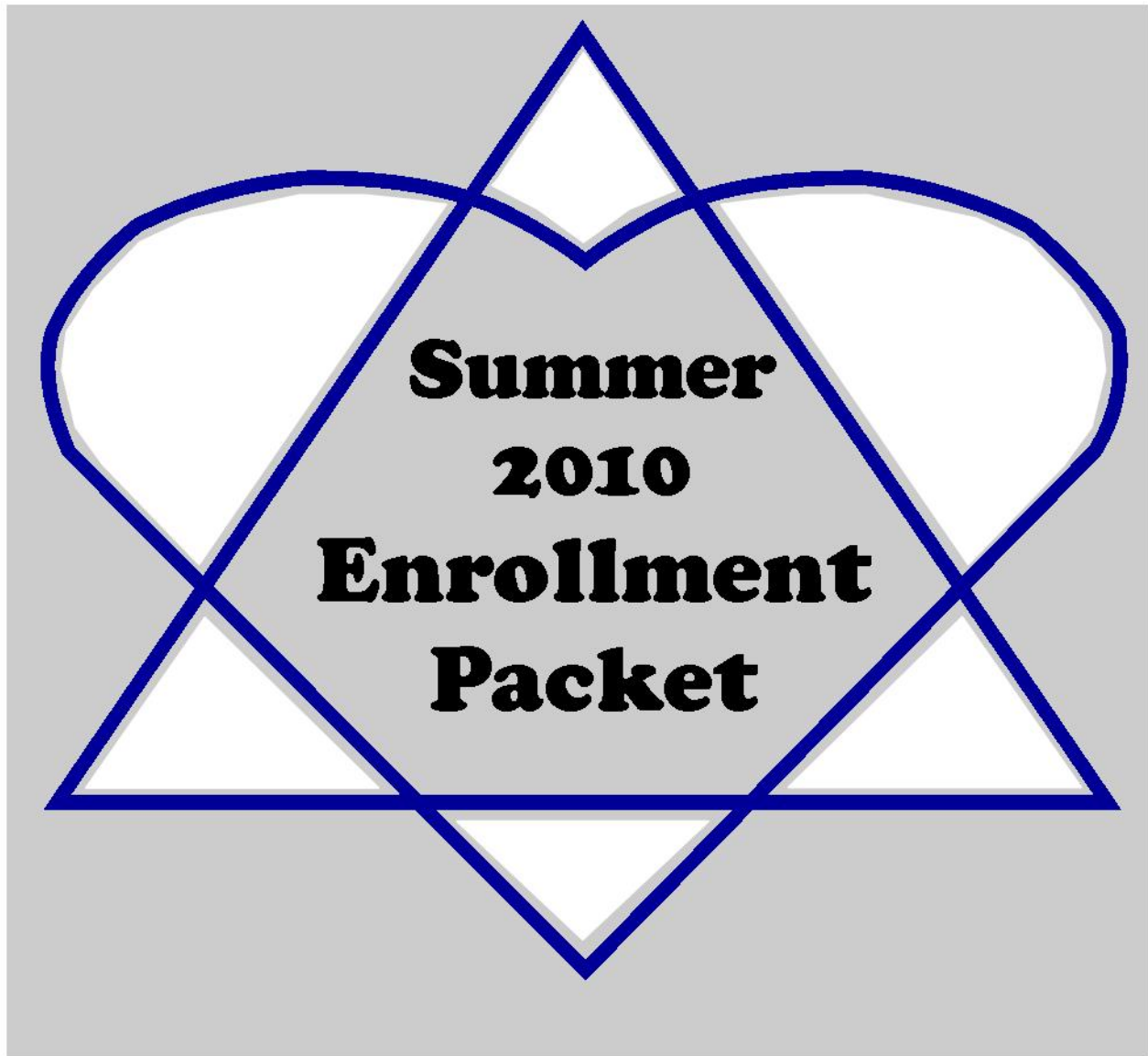

WHAT'S INCLUDED

POLICIES

Credit card fee: a 3% convenience fee will be added to credit card payments.

Insurance: Guardians are responsible for providing primary health insurance for their children. CCP must have proof of medical insurance prior to any child's acceptance.

Visitors: The campground may be visited during our scheduled **Open House on April 4, 2010**. Visitors are not allowed during the camping season.

Care packages: Please do not send food. All camper packages will be opened in the camp office in the presence of the camper and all food items will be confiscated.

Cellular phones: CCP does not permit campers to keep cellular phones and/or other communication devices (i.e., laptop computers, pagers, PDAs, etc.) with them while at camp. These items will be confiscated and stored in the camp office until the conclusion of the child's session.

Special needs: CCP will make every effort to accommodate campers with special needs, but it is not always appropriate or possible. Please contact the camp office in advance of sending in this application to discuss your specific circumstances.

Refunds for payments above and beyond registration fee will be given if notice of cancellation is given a minimum of one month prior to camp start date. Camp Charles Pearlstein accepts no responsibility for loss, damage, or theft of camper's property. Parents or Guardians will be held financially responsible for vandalism caused by their child. Camp Charles Pearlstein does not permit discrimination because of race, color, sex, age, handicap, or national origin.

I further agree: I hereby give permission for my child to leave campgrounds for programs under supervision of Camp staff. Camp Charles Pearlstein may use photographs of my child to post on the camp website or for public relations purposes. The Camp may send my child home for behavior detrimental to the Camp Community at the sole discretion of the Camp Director. I have read and accept this registration agreement.
