WHAT'S INCLUDED

Room and board, all programs and supplies, weekly laundry service, regular visits to the *Shook* (camp store), and local (Phoenix and Tucson) transportation.

Please note: Airline arrivals and departures for campers flying to Phoenix are the responsibility of the family, and must be coordinated with camp officials in advance.

DISCOUNTS/INCENTIVES

First-timer incentives: Up to \$1,000.00 off your tuition. Available to first-time campers (some restrictions apply). Please see our website for details.

Referral discount: \$50 off your tuition for every NEW camper that you refer to CCP. Your name must be listed on the new camper's registration form.

Sibling discount: 10% off second (and subsequent) child(ren).

Full-time Jewish Communal Professional discount: 25% off given rate (other discounts not applicable).

Community Clergy discount: 1/3 off given rate (must be employed full-time in a clergy capacity in our target community; other discounts not applicable).

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

CCP is committed to working with families to make camp affordable. We offer incentives, payment plans, and need-based scholarships. Please see our website for details.

Please note: Scholarship application deadline is **February 29, 2012**. Awards will be determined by March 15, 2012. A scholarship application instructions are available on our website.

POLICIES

Credit card fee: a 3% convenience fee will be added to credit card payments.

Insurance: Guardians are responsible for providing primary health insurance for their children. CCP must have proof of medical insurance prior to any child's acceptance.

Visitors: The campground may be visited during our scheduled **Open House** on **March 25, 2012**. Visitors are not allowed during the camping season.

Care packages: ****NEW POLICY FOR 2012****: Each camper will be limited to **ONE PACKAGE PER WEEK** that he/she is in attendance at camp. Please do not send food, water balloons or hazardous items. All camper packages will be opened in the camp office in the presence of the camper and prohibited items will be confiscated.

Cellular phones: CCP does not permit campers to keep cellular phones and/or other communication devices (i.e., laptop computers, PDAs, etc.) with them while at camp. These items will be confiscated and stored in the camp office until the conclusion of the child's session.

Special needs: CCP will make every effort to accommodate campers with special needs, but it is not always appropriate or possible. Please contact the camp office in advance of sending in this application to discuss your specific circumstances.

Camp Charles Pearlstein does not permit discrimination because of race, color, sex, age, handicap, or national origin.
