SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. With a co-Specialist, plan and implement high/low ropes course and climbing wall programs for all age groups. To include Cabin Hours, Haggigah and Chugim.
2. Attend training program if one is offered.
4. Orient and educate of Staff to Climbing Wall and Ropes course equipment, procedures, rules and availability.
5. Communicate with Health Center regarding campers with special physical needs or problems, with regards to your specialty area and observance of those needs.
6. Prepare and maintain Climbing Wall and Ropes Courses - Physically and programmatically.
7. Assist with camper arrival, departure, luggage etc.
8. Maintain record of camper's progress in specialty area.
9. Maintain involvement in programs including: planning, facilitating, set-up, clean-up and preparation of materials.
10. Requisition needed supplies and equipment, as well as, maintain and take inventory of all equipment and supplies.
11. Evaluate in writing, Rock Climbing Program, Ropes Course Program Camp Program, etc., making suggestions for the future.
12. Abide by and enforce all camp policies.
13. Walk Shmira (OD) as assigned, supervise all cabins at night.
